ALTAR FLOWERS: Altar flowers are donated this morning by the Guffey family.

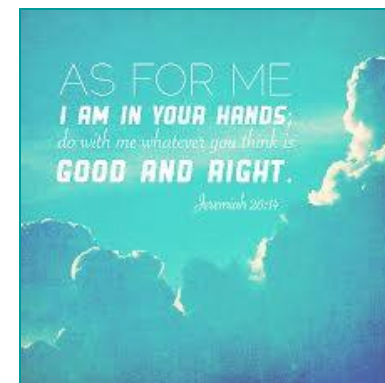
FELLOWSHIP HOUR: Join us following the services this morning for refreshments and fellowship. We would like to thank the Edgett family for serving us this morning.
